

WHAT IS THE IMO 6.09 TRAIN THE TRAINER MODEL COURSE?

IMO Train the Trainer 6.09 will qualify you to teach most STCW and MCA Courses. Upon successful completion you will be able to;

- Instruct [CT HSE First Aid Courses](#) (assuming [First Aid at Work](#) or higher)
- Progress to one of the [RYA Shorebased Instructor Courses](#), (this is a substitute to [RYA TIC \(Teaching in the Classroom\)](#))

The course is aimed at two groups of professionals;

- Those writing [MCA/STCW course](#) programmes for MCA approval
- Those who want to teach MCA, STCW, RYA shorebased or HSE First aid Courses

This is a 4 or 5 day (0915-1630) course with some pre course preparation and some homework each evening.

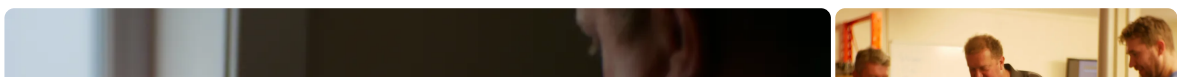
WHAT ARE THE PRE REQUISITES FOR THE IMO TRAINING COURSE FOR INSTRUCTORS?

- Minimum age 18
- Basic numeracy and written/spoken English
- Familiar with common office software (i.e. Word, Excel, Powerpoint)
- Hold at least two STCW certificates
- Have specialist knowledge in at least one of the following;

WHAT IS COVERED ON THE IMO 6.09 MODEL COURSE?

- STCW Convention & Code requirements for competence-based training
- Planning an effective learning environment
- Training aids
- Use teaching activities effectively
- Producing a subject related lesson plan
- Evaluating teaching and learning
- Advanced Powerpoint design/use
- Course design

During the course you will deliver multiple short talks, lead a discussion and have plenty opportunities to practice giving feedback to others.

The IMO recommend a maximum ratio of Candidates to Instructor of 24:1. We don't believe a centre can train effective Instructors at that ratio so we choose to limit our course to 8:1 and for several parts of the course we improve on that. We run the IMO 6.09 Train the Trainer Model Course with anything from 2 to 8 candidates.

The IMO 6.09 Train the Trainer Certificate does not expire, however Instructors and their Training Centres should ensure they remain in date with Continual Professional Development (CPD).
